Improved work practices and ultimately an improvement in overall delivery of primary health services to the community.

Newtown Union Health have recently upgraded their software thanks to TechSoup NZ and Microsoft. Odette Wood, Newtown Union Health's Operation Manager explains the impact on their organization.

"It has enabled us to achieve a number of things including improved email capability, the ability for everyone to "hot-desk", a standard suite of MS Office software so everyone is using the same version and future upgrades can be done across the whole network at once and an improved central storage of our organisation's documents.

At a higher level, the upgrade means a much more robust system, less maintenance costs/risks, better internal communication systems and processes and the increased ability to support a growing organization spread across geographically separated sites as we move into the future.

Without the support from TechSoup and Microsoft we would not have been able to do this. The substantially reduced software costs have meant that we have been able to do so much more with the money we have spent. Even our IT technical support service provider was astounded and excited at the significant savings we were making by buying our Microsoft software through TechSoup and that enabled them to do a bigger upgrade for us than was initially planned before we registered with TechSoup.

As a not-for-profit community-based primary health service, costs are always an issue for us as we don't have the big budgets to be able to do everything we want, when we want. The development and growth of our IT systems and technology has to date been ad hoc and only as we could afford. TechSoup and Microsoft have changed this and we are now at a stage that we have only dreamed of.

It may seem small scale in comparison to upgrades in the corporate sector but it is a major achievement for us. Of course, the biggest flow on effect of improving our IT systems will be better access for staff and therefore improved work practices and ultimately an improvement in overall delivery of primary health services to our community.
