Used as an Intranet and File storage (alt. to File Server)



Part of most 365
Plans including E1
and Basic



For Internal Use Primarily



For Organisational Usage rather than Individual storage



DIRECTLY THROUGH THE MICROSOFT 365 APPS (WORD, EXCEL, ETC.)




SYNCED TO YOUR PC (NOT EVERYTHING! PAIN!).

Microsoft 365 Groups

- A SharePoint team site has a Microsoft 365 Group.
- Every 'Teams' team has a Microsoft 365 Group.
- Has a 'Shared Mailbox'

Office 365 Groups Building Blocks









Getting start - optimally

Not taking a 'Big Bang' approach.	
Agree on Structure	
Which Teams & who is in each team.	
Which Sites (Communication).	
Which Hubs.	
Which channels (not as important).	

Sharepoint – Adoption Tips



Create reasons to go there



Consider 'champions' in your team



Visual appeal (good images) is important



Some training may be beneficial

IT Process & Governance (over these tools)

- Teams/Sharepoint Self evolution is important
- Put some restrictions in place documented
- Consider some key areas to have perimeters (General, HR)
- Sensitive areas need more protection and governance
- Compliance large area to consider
