WHAT IS POWER AUTOMATE?



- Microsoft Product/Service (part of Office 365)
- Part of the Microsoft Power Platform
- Formerly called Microsoft Flow
- For organisations and individuals
- Low or no code
- Many templates available
- Cloud, Mobile, Desktop



WHY CONSIDER AUTOMATION/PAPERLESS?


- Environmental factors
- Improve and accelerate processes
- Implementing processes easily
- Allow your organisation to function (in a lockdown scenario!)
- Keep tight records (digitally) of all activity





PROCESSES THAT ARE COMMONLY PAPER BASED

- Time Sheets
- Purchase requests
- Expense Claims
- Credit Card requests
- H&S Incidents
- Travel Requests
- New Client/Contact Forms
- Staff Induction





Individual Flows



Individual Flows

- Often buttons, can be scheduled/triggered
- Can often be achieved by other means, but keeps things in one place to manage
- Create on mobile, or web
- Great way to learn
- Can be shared with others



Individual Flow Examples

- Set yourself a reminder
- Get a push notification for emails from your manager
- Get the weather forecast delivered daily
- Create a task in Planner when an email is flagged
- Block out my calendar for the next hour

Forms

- Microsoft tool
- Easy way to gather data input
- Mobile friendly, embed in Teams or Sharepoint
- Quick to build, and easy to use
- Power Automate enables useful access to the data



Form Examples

- Credit Card approval
- Health & Safety notification
- Induction information gathering
- Timesheet logging
- Leave approval
- Collating feedback
- Any time you need to get consistent information, and take action

Sometimes it won't work the way you're expecting, remove and try again!


Watch out for password expiry – dedicate an account.
